for **Nooks, Sony eReaders, Kobo**  
and Other Devices that support DRM (Digital Rights Management)

### Step 1: Get an Adobe ID

You can get an Adobe ID at [www.adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com). Click Sign in and create an adobe account. *Be sure to use the same email that you used to register your device!*

### Step 2: Install Adobe® Digital Editions on your Computer

Adobe Digital Editions is a free eBook reader used to read DRM-protected EPUB and PDFfiles. It can be downloaded from <http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/> or via [Live-brary.com](http://Live-brary.com) Downloads at check out.

### Step 3: Activate with Your Adobe ID

*Note that both Adobe Digital Editions and your device must be activated with the same Adobe ID to transfer DRM-protected Adobe eBooks to the device.*

1. Connect the eBook reader to your computer
2. Open Adobe Digital Editions. Adobe Digital Editions launches and detects your device and the Device Setup Assistant dialog box is displayed
3. Click **Authorize Device**. Adobe Digital Editions activates your eBook Reader. You can now transfer DRM-protected Adobe eBooks to the device

**Activate Adobe Digital Editions with an Adobe ID,  
not anonymously.**

### Step 3: Downloading

- Our downloadable ebooks can be borrowed from [Live-brary.com](http://Live-brary.com)
- eBooks do not have to be returned but they do expire when the loan period is up
- There are different types of items. You want to look for .epubs.
- Go to [Live-brary.com](http://Live-brary.com)
- Click on **Downloads**



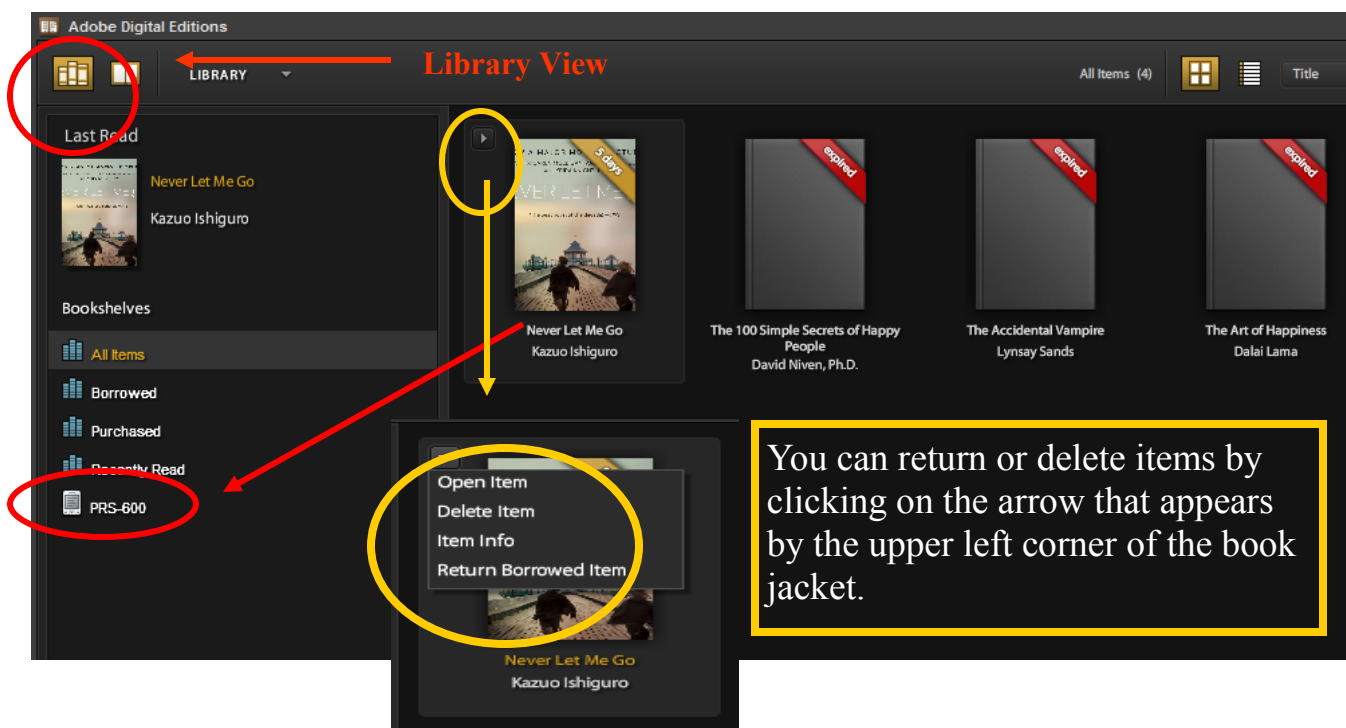
- You can browse all eBooks via the link on the left side bar or use the search box
- Select the book jacket of the eBook you want. Click **Add to My Cart**. Follow the steps through **Confirm Checkout**
- If you had not already signed in, you will be prompted to select your library and enter your library card number
- Click the **Download** button and the eBook will open in Adobe Digital Editions. *Be sure your reader is plugged in before hitting the download button*. Some computer setups may prompt you to click Open .



**Tip:** To search only for .epubs, click on **Advanced Search** and set format to .epub eBook . You can also check **Only show titles with copies available** if you want to see items that are currently available

### Step 4: Transferring to your Device

- In Adobe Digital Editions, the book will download in reading mode, you need to switch to Library View.
- You should see an icon representing your reader at the bottom left
- Drag the eBook title to the reader icon in the left pane of Adobe Digital Editions. If the transfer is successful, you should see a **green plus sign**.



- You can now disconnect your device.
- Library books may show up in "My Documents," the Digital Editions folder or "My files"
