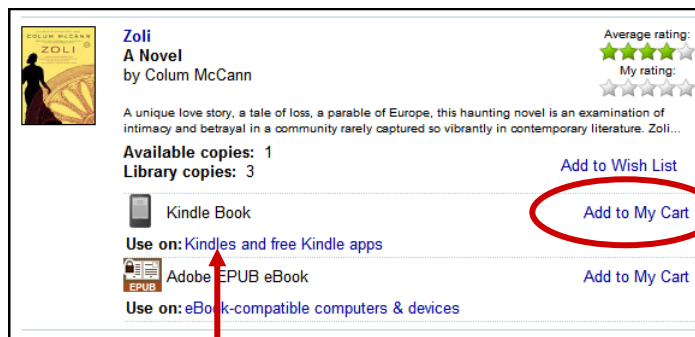




Downloading library books to your **Kindle Fire**

1. Go to **Live-brary.com**

- Click on **Downloads**
- You can browse all eBooks via the link on the left side bar or use the search box
- Select the book jacket of the book you are interested in borrowing



If no copies were available, this would say “Add to Waitlist”

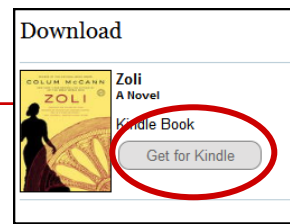
There are different types of items. You want to look for “Kindle Book”

- Click **Add to My Cart**. Follow the steps through **Confirm Checkout**
- When prompted select your library and enter your library card number
- You will be offered a 7 or 14 day loan.

Tip: To search only for Kindle Books, click on **Advanced Search** and set format to Kindle Book . You can also check **Only show titles with copies available** if you want to see items that are currently available

2. Finish at Amazon

When you hit the Get for Kindle button, you will be sent to Amazon.com to complete the download.



At Amazon, select “Get Library Book.”

You may also need to sign in to your Amazon Account.

After downloading your book, go to your device’s **settings** and hit the **sync** icon to make the book appear on your Kindle

No need to return; our Kindle Books will expire when the loan period is up but if you wish to return an item early:

- go to **Manage My Kindle @ Amazon**
- open the drop down menu to the right of the item you wish to return
- **select return**

You can have up to **5** Kindle books checked out on your library card at one time
